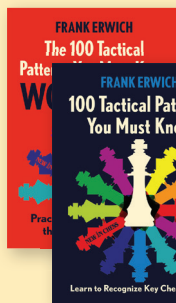
The Real Paul Morphy by Charles Hertan (24 July 2024)

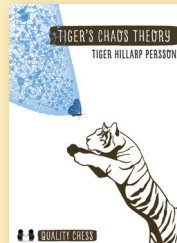


100 Tactical Patterns You Must Know by Frank Erwich (24 July 2024)

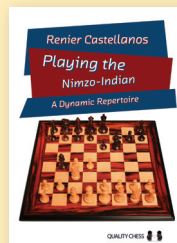
The 100 Tactical Patterns You Must Know Workbook (7 August 2024) – Erwich collected hundreds of exercises to train the patterns.

Playing the Nimzo-Indian by Renier Castellanos (21 August 2024)

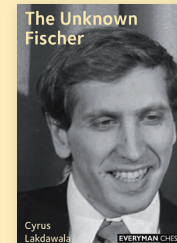

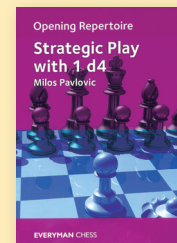
The Unknown Fischer by Cyrus Lakdawala
