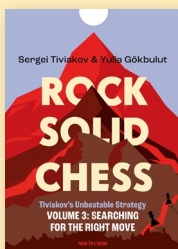


## Botvinnik's Best Games

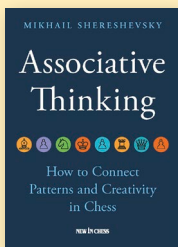


## Rock Solid Chess - Volume 3

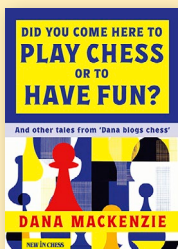


## Associative Thinking
